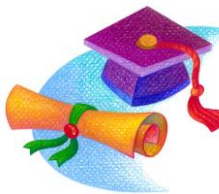

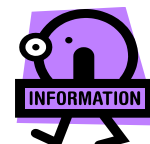

**Horatio Alger Ontario Scholarship Program:** Students graduating in spring 2015, entering college or university in the fall 2015, family annual net income of \$55,000 or less, involvement in extracurricular and community activities, displays integrity and perseverance in overcoming adversity, a minimum percentage of 65, a desire to contribute to society, and a Canadian citizen. Deadline: **October 25, 2014**

**U of T National Scholarship Program (The Bank of Montreal National Scholarship):** Superior academic performance, exceptional achievement in a broad context, enthusiasm for intellectual exploration & involvement in the school & community life. Deadline: **November 7, 2014**
